Message from Rev'd Adam Wells

Dear Friends,

A very warm welcome to this Plan and Newsletter for March, April, and May 2026. During this plan, we will move from the reflective time of Lent into the joy of Easter as we celebrate once again the resurrection of the Lord Jesus Christ from the dead. I hope that you have a holy Lent and a joyful Easter.

The Circuit Lent Groups including times and venues are listed below. The course is based around four passages from Paul's letter to the Romans, which we will be using during four of the Sundays in Lent. For reference and preparation, we will be using the People's Bible Commentary on Romans, written by James DG Dunn. The commentary is available new and second hand from a variety of places and is an accessible read, yet contains the benefits of the scholarship of the late Professor Dunn.

The letter to the Romans is different to Paul's other letters. He is writing to churches he has not visited and which have come into being without his missionary efforts, though it is the case that Paul met some believers from Rome in other places where he worked. The letter to the Romans provides the fullest exposition of Paul's theology in the New Testament. I hope that the passages we have chosen to study will whet your appetite and encourage you to look at the rest of the letter as well.

Every blessing as we journey through Lent and into Eastertide together.
