Message from Rev'd Adam Wells

Dear Friends,

I hope you have all had a good summer and have managed to cope with the extremely hot weather. Our hearts go out to those abroad and also in this country, who have suffered from the ravages of fires that have threatened their very lives.

During September and October, each Church in the Circuit will be using the 2026 Bible month material, which is based on Paul's letter to the Philippians. The Bible Month material runs for four sessions and will be accompanied by Bible studies in various places. The services using the Bible Month material have been labelled 'BM 1', 'BM 2' etc. In weeks not labelled 'BM', normal services will take place.

Many of us enjoyed, and benefitted from, engaging with Paul's letter to the Romans in Lent this year, so I hope that as many as possible will join in the Bible studies for Bible month. I am confident that we will feel enriched, challenged and will draw closer to God through this course.

At the Methodist Conference this year, 'On The Way' was launched. 'On The Way' is a short course for people who want space to explore Christian faith, connect it with everyday life, and ask honest questions together. It is suitable for those who are exploring for the first time and also for those who wish a time of refreshment. Again, I hope that as many as possible will engage with this course. Dates for this course will be worked out by individual churches.
